NOTE: World languages & cultures, oral communication, and Core 250 or Core 350 are waived for nursing majors. Global perspectives, mathematical reasoning, social sciences, and the natural sciences general education requirements are met by nursing prerequisites and/or upper-division nursing coursework. Students must complete 32 credits of nursing prerequisites and all Whitworth University general education requirements prior to the upper-division nursing major. For students who have earned an AA degree prior to transfer to Whitworth, general education requirements are waived except one biblical literature course and one Core course. No more than three prerequisite courses may remain to be completed during the semester the application is being considered. **Students will be required to take one 300-level, three-semester-credit, non-nursing course before graduating. This course can be taken at Whitworth or at WSU.**
